PATTY FERRANT: Get set up correctly. Have all your supplies out. Hi. Have all those supplies out ready to go. Homework, binder minder on the side, quickly. There's no time to talk. There's definitely no time to talk right now. Let's go, let's go, let's go.

Thanks for having the supplies out. Let's go. So it looks like as I'm looking around...almost everybody has their job done. Leave it, just leave it. We're done. The bell has rung. So you are now going over your homework with your partner. Why is there no homework written from yesterday...or from the day before?

STUDENT: I don't know.

PATTY FERRANT: So write it down now. You need to write your homework every day. You need to check your partner and make sure he writes his homework every single day. So look at that side now and then you can talk to your partner about it.

It's just the way the class rolls, right? So deal with it. It's okay, you can have your two stamps now but do that for me every day. All right? Thank you. Okay, show me the homework. Tell your partner what is the homework tonight.

STUDENT: Number one, A and B.

PATTY FERRANT: Put it inside your folder. That is your math folder. I don't want you to lose your papers. That's why we're trying to be organized.
