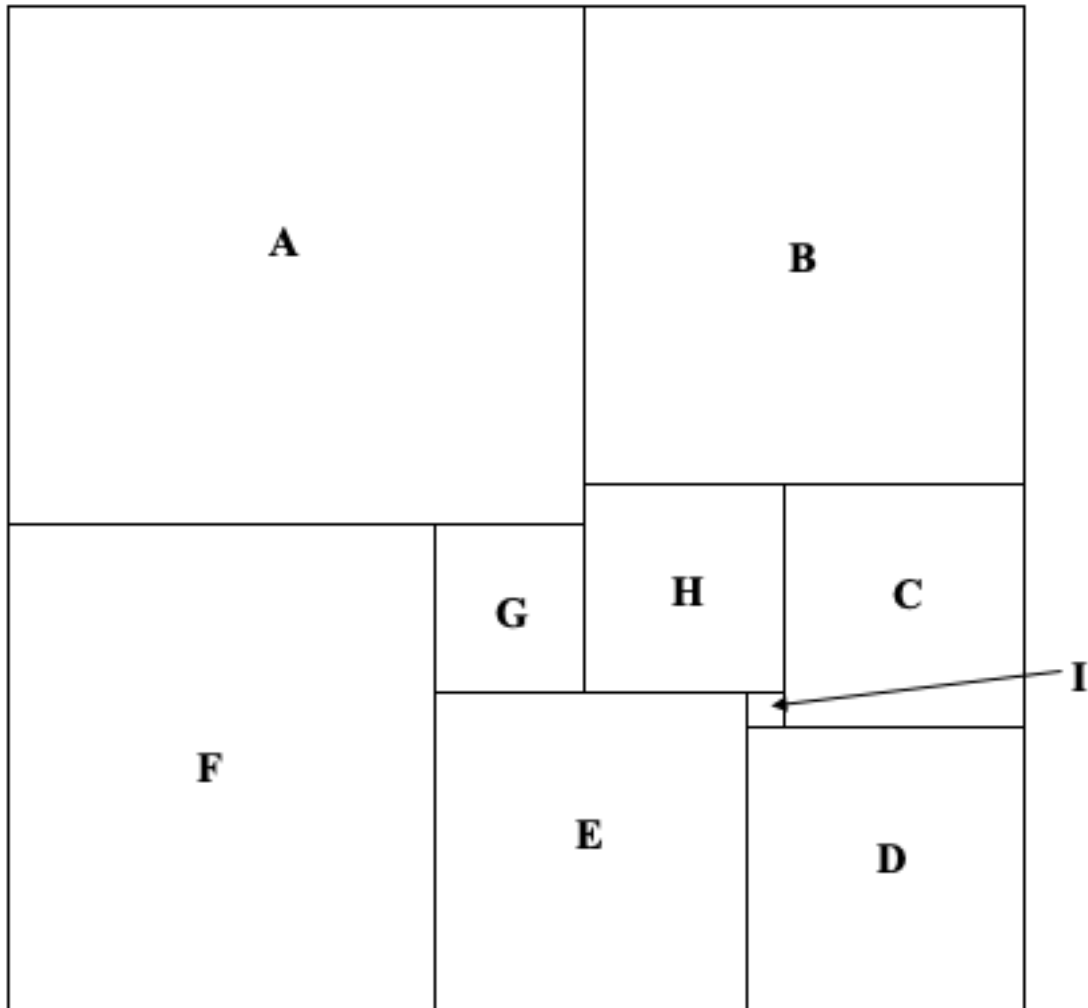


## Polly Gone
